## "FUN" FACTS

- Plastic bags are used for an average of 12 minutes, but a single bag has a life expectancy of up to 1,000 years.
- The average American family takes home almost 1,500 plastic shopping bags a year.
- Approximately 500 billion plastic bags are used worldwide annually. More than one million bags are used every minute.

- The U.S. uses 100 billion plastic shopping bags annually. An estimated 12 million barrels of oil is required to make that many plastic bags.
- Number of marine animalskilled each year due to plastic bags: 100,000
- Only $1 \%$ of plastic bags are returned for recycling.

## REUSEABLE BAGS

In 2019 there were 618,795 people in Monmouth County NJ. Based on the statistics, that's $928,192,500$ plastic bags a year.

Read that again. I had to, be cause that's unbelievable.


These are my own produce bags. This haul alone saved 8 plastic produce bags and at least 15 grocery bags.

That may seem like a drop in the bucket but if we all made this change, in just our county?

# ALTERNATIVE OPTIONS FOR: 

## GROCERY STORE BAGS *

You can't go wrong with a tote!
This is a great opportunity to shop local!
Try to find ones made of recycled material, like this one from Interwoven in AsburyPark, NJ.

## INTERWOVEN X BAGGU

 REUSABLE LEOPARD BAG- Holds 2-3 plastic grocery bags worth of stuff.
- Made from 40\% recycled nylon sourced from pre-consumer waste.
- Holds 50 lbs .

While some reusable bags have their own environmental issues (Google Denmark Reusable Bag Study) overall, they're still better than constantly putting more single use plastic that won't

# ALTERNATIVE OPTIONS FOR: 

## PRODUCE BAGS

Bag up veggies and bulk grans, beans and nuts in these produce bags.

Simple Ecology's
Muslin Reuseable Produce Bags


- Natural, organic, fabric
- Bonus: These bags slow produce decay by allowing ethylene gas to escape while storing food in the refrigerator and pantry, keeping fruits and vegetables fresh longer.
- One of a select few US-based companies certified by the Global Organic Textile Standard (GOTS), for strict environmental \& social (workers) criteria.
- Available on Amazon in a variety of sizes


# ALTERNATIVE OPTIONS FOR: 

## SANDWICH \& SNACK BAGS

(Yknow...ZiplocBags)

## BioBags

- Take about 3-6 months to fully decompose (vs hundreds of years for a plastic bag)
- Made from plants, vegetable oils, and compostable polymers, and it can be consumed by microorganisms
- Available at Grove Collective
 (at a comparable price to regular snack bags)
- BPA Free



## Stasher Bags

- Dishwasher safe, oven safe, fridge and freezer friendly, microwave safe
- Silicone is inert, non-toxic, and safe for food
- It resists microbes and holds up to hot and cold temperatures
- Variety of sizes
- BPA Free
